

Paying with Reka money – it's easy

It's easy to pay for Mobility services with Reka money (Reka Checks, Reka Card or Reka Rail). Reka money cannot be used to pay for vouchers, or the cooperative share certificate, or to settle claims for damage.

Post your Reka Checks with this form to Mobility. It's a good idea to send the checks by registered post (maximum CHF 500 at a time), since Mobility accepts no liability for any loss, and the liability of SwissPost is limited.

Do you hold a Reka Card? You can use it to settle your bills via www.rekanet.ch.

General preconditions for paying with Reka money

- The value of the Reka Checks must be CHF 200 or more.
- For administrative reasons, Reka money can be credited to your Mobility customer account only as prepayment for the procurement of a service (kilometre and hourly rates, subscription charges).
- Reka checks can take up to 15 days to clear. Please allow enough time for this when sending in your checks so that they can be reflected in your next invoice.
